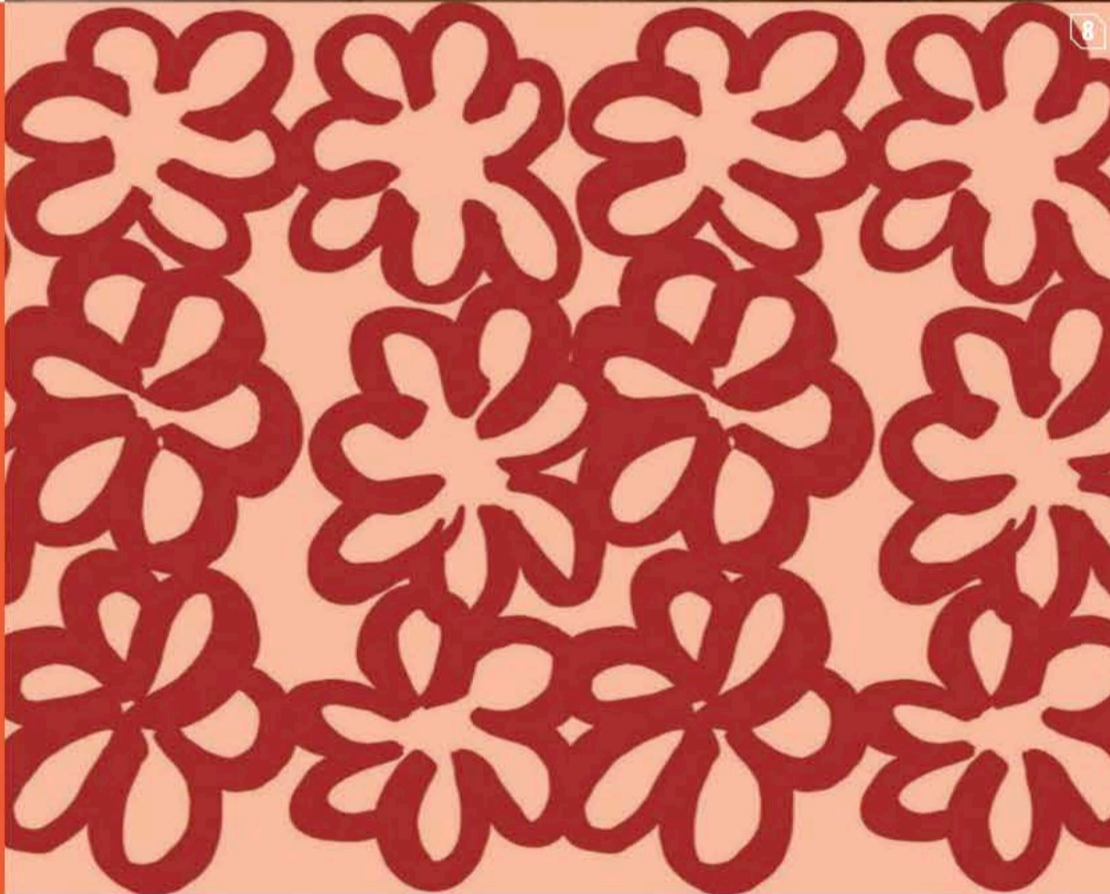

standout One of the brand founder's earliest and most popular patterns, a "classy yet sassy" angled grid motif that up close turns out to be stocking-clad legs, is now available in new colors of matte clay-coated paper wallcovering. flavorpaper.com
