## Designer Jeffrey Beers Shares His Favorite Pieces For a Modern Refresh

Jeffrey Beers, Mansion Global Boutique's guest curator, is an architect, interior designer and artist whose work brings emotion to modernism. He studied architecture at the Rhode Island School of Design and formed his namesake firm, Jeffrey Beers International, in 1986. He's brought his signature sensibility to some of New York's most vibrant restaurants and quickly expanded into hotels, resorts and residences around the world. You can see Mr. Beers' signature style in luxury destinations such as the One & Only in Cabo San Lucas and restaurants like Gordon Ramsay's Hell's Kitchen.

Mr. Beers has learned from some of the best in the business. While at RISD, he learned glassblowing from the renowned artist Dale Chihuly. He was awarded a Fulbright scholarship and traveled to Brazil to study with the legendary Oscar Niemeyer, and later went to work for I.M. Pei. These masters helped define his vision: the dynamic use of space, subtle materiality and tailored elegance. His current collaborations with various home design companies such as [AKDO](#), [Maya Romanoff](#) and [Walters Wicker](#) show his true passion for elevated design.

In addition to resorts and restaurants, Mr. Beers specializes in high-end homes, including a 61st-floor apartment at One57, where the JBI team focused on layering warm furnishings, luxurious finishes and show-stopping artwork. His studio emphasizes custom fixtures, sensitivity to the texture and color of materials, and elegant proportions when designing interiors.

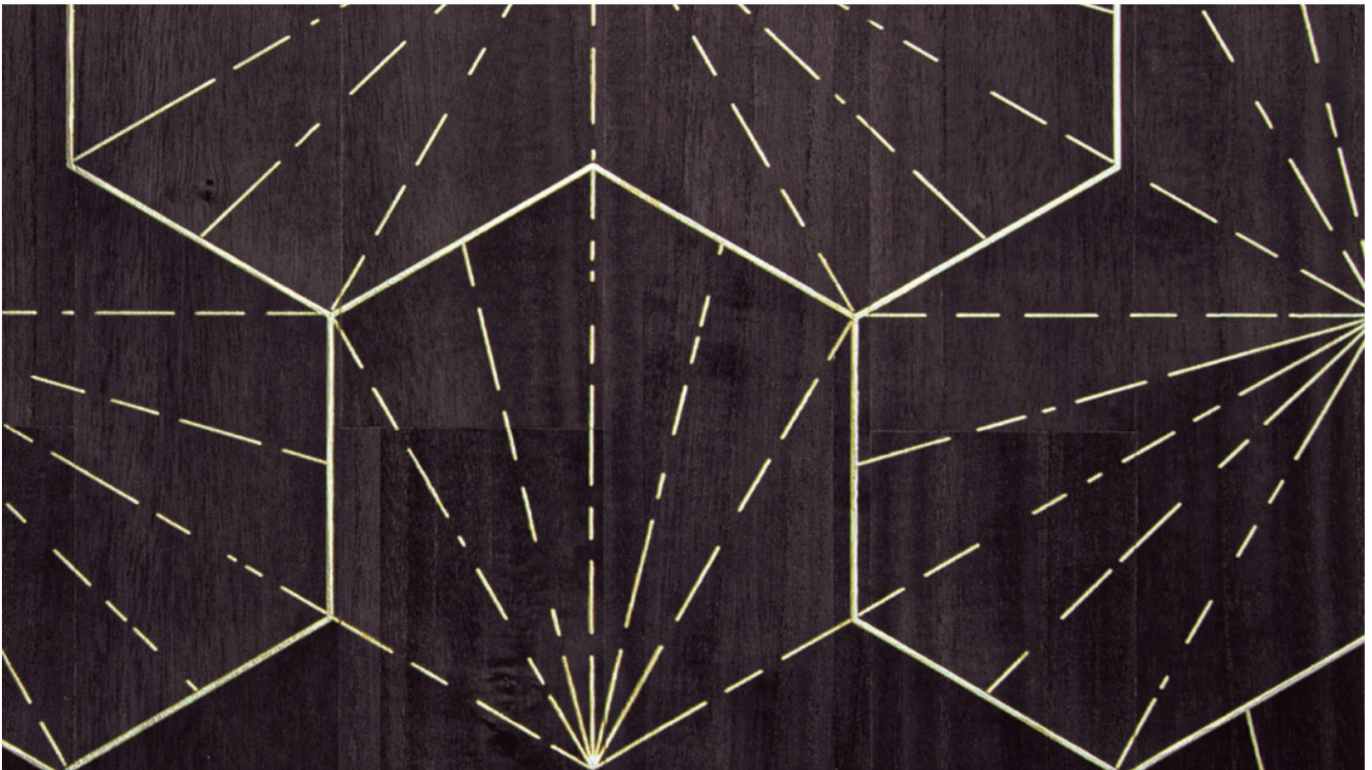
