Care, Cleaning & Disinfecting Guide

MAINTENANCE TIPS

Proper care and routine maintenance of your wallcovering will help preserve its beauty.

- **Avoid direct or reflected sunlight.** Our wallcoverings are not guaranteed against fading or color change.
- Maya Romanoff wallcoverings are formulated for dry-use areas.
- Before cleaning any wallcoverings, test first on a small, inconspicuous area.
- **Avoid** getting the wallcovering excessively wet.
- **Never use abrasive cleansers or steel wool** as they will mar the surface.
- Clean by blotting the soiled area with a soft, clean cloth, dampened with a mild solution of clear liquid detergent. Dry with a soft, clean cloth.
- **Do not use harsh cleaners, solvents, or chemicals** of any kind to clean Maya Romanoff products unless following our special guidelines.

SPECIAL CLEANING GUIDELINES

When used as directed, disinfectant wipes and diluted bleach detergent/water solutions can be safe and effective sanitization methods on the majority of our wallcoverings.

- Chloride bleach should always be diluted with water, and never be applied at full strength.
- To properly dilute bleach for disinfecting wallcovering, mix 1 part bleach to 50 parts water (approx. 5 tablespoons of bleach to one gallon of water).
- Make sure the wallcovering surface is free of loose dirt or dust.
- With a soft, clean cloth, gently wipe the surface with the diluted bleach/water solution. **Do not rub.**
- Make sure there is proper ventilation.
- Allow solution one minute to set; then use a soft, clean cloth to carefully wipe down the surface. **Do not rub.** Allow time for air dry.

⚠ **NOTE** Before proceeding with the process, test first on a small, inconspicuous area to ensure there will be no damage to the wallcovering. When using disinfectant wipes, wipe gently; Do not rub.



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
